

Position Description Safety Officer

Summary

Role is responsible for a ensuring a safe environment during the festival. This is a 'hands-on' role during the festival and may require quick decisions and actions to ensure safety.

Key responsibilities

- Check all festival venues for safety before the festival
- Ensure festival precinct and venues are safe environments for volunteers, performers and visitors
- Co-ordinate any action required to address safety issues during the festival.

Skills required

- Awareness of safety issues including trip hazards, manual handling issues, road safety, crowd control
- Problem-solving and negotiation
- Ability to act decisively if required

During festival	Regularly monitor the festival precinct and all venues during the festival to check for safety issues
	Be on call to check and act on safety concerns from volunteers, performers and visitors
After festival	Report to NFFC Committee about safety incidents and concerns, make recommendations for future festivals.
